AFFIRM'S NOTICE OF CONSENT TO SPIN-OFF OF ISSUES <u>AND</u> WITHDRAWAL OF DIRECT TESTIMONY OF RUSSELL KLEPPER

On September 22, 2010, AFFIRM filed in this proceeding the Direct Testimony of Russel Klepper. On September 27, 2010, AFFIRM filed its Preliminary List of Issues and Positions. During the informal issued identification conference this date, Staff recommended that AFFIRM's issues be addressed in existing Docket No. 100358-EI (Investigation into the design of Commercial Time-of-Use rates by Florida Power & Light, pursuant to Order No. PSC-10-0153-FOF-EI), rather than in the instant docket. Based on AFFIRM's understanding that the other parties in this docket (including Florida Power & Light Company) do not object to this approach and the resulting expansion of Docket No. 100358-EI, AFFIRM hereby agrees to having the issues included in that docket for determination. As a result of the spin-off of AFFIRM's issues into Docket No. 100358-EI, the Direct Testimony of Russell Klepper is no longer appropriate for the issues before the Commission in the instant proceeding. AFFIRM therefore withdraws his testimony.
