COMMISSIONER EDGAR: And we will move on to the next docket, which is 02, energy conservation.

Ms. Tan, any preliminary matters for this docket?

MS. TAN: There are no preliminary matters at this time. We note that it appears that all issues in this docket are stipulated, noting that FIPUG and OPC take no position.

COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Any comments from any of the parties before we go section-by-section? Okay. Hearing none, then, similarly, we will go quickly through the draft prehearing order section-by-section heading. If you have any comments, please speak right up.

Section I, case background. Section II, conduct of proceedings. Section III, jurisdiction. Section IV, procedure for handling confidential information. Section V, prefiled testimony and exhibits. Section VI, order of witnesses.

MS. TAN: Commissioner, it appears that all witnesses in this docket may also be excused. After this prehearing conference, we will confer with the Commissioners and advise the parties whether or not that can happen.

COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Counsel, any concerns 1 about that? No. 2 MR. BUTLER: No. 3 COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Okay. We are all in 4 agreement. Then, Section VII, basic positions. 5 6 MS. KAUFMAN: Commissioner, I do have a change 7 on that for FIPUG that I just don't think it got picked up. But at any rate, our basic position would be none 8 9 at this time, so we would delete what's in the draft. 10 COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Okay. Ms. Tan. 11 MS. TAN: We will take care of that. 12 COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Okay. All right. Thank 13 you very much, Ms. Kaufman. 14 Any other changes -- excuse me. Everybody at 15 my house is battling a cold, and I think we're losing. 16 I apologize. 17 Okay. Any other changes to Section VIII? 18 MR. BUTLER: No. COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Okay. We will move on 19 20 Section IX. then. 21 MS. TAN: Staff will prepare a Comprehensive 22 Exhibit List which contains all the prefiled testimony, 23 and we will provide it to the parties. 24 COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Okay. Section X. 25 MS. TAN: There are proposed stipulations on

all issues, noting that FIPUG and OPC have taken no 1 2 position. COMMISSIONER EDGAR: And, again, everybody 3 comfortable with the language as it's described in the 4 5 draft prehearing order? Okay. 6 Section XI, pending motions. Mr. Butler. 7 MR. BUTLER: I'm sorry. I apologize for interrupting. Going back to Section IX, the exhibit 8 9 list, maybe I'm just confused here. I have in my 10 notebook here a document that I thought was the 11 Comprehensive Exhibit List, and I'm wondering is that --12 MS. TAN: Yes, we have e-mailed it out. 13 MR. BUTLER: I'm sorry? 14 MS. TAN: Yes, that is the correct 15 Comprehensive Exhibit List. MR. BUTLER: Okay. I was just wondering if 16 17 there are no objections to it, go ahead and --18 MS. TAN: There are no objections. 19 MR. BUTLER: -- get that on the record. 20 we don't have any objections to it, and it sounded like 21 that it was something to come, and I thought if we could 22 get it wrapped up here maybe we could just go ahead and 23 do that. COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Okay. So the proposed 24 25 Comprehensive Exhibit List, which shows Exhibits 1

through 4, is that the document that we are all --1 2 MS. TAN: Yes. 3 COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Is that the correct version? 4 5 MS. TAN: Yes. 6 COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Okay. And so at this 7 point, are there any proposed changes to this document? No. Okay. So we can recognize this as the proposed 8 9 Comprehensive Exhibit List that has been agreed to by 10 all parties, and then leave it for entering at the 11 hearing. Does that work for you? 12 MR. BUTLER: That's great. That would be fine. Thank you. 13 14 COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Okay. Then that brings 15 us back to Section X, proposed stipulations. 16 In the proposed stipulations there MS. TAN: 17 are proposed stipulations on all issues, noting that 18 FIPUG and OPC have taken no position. 19 COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Okay. And, Ms. Kaufman, 20 you are reflected accurately? 21 MS. KAUFMAN: I am. Thank you, Commissioner. 22 COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Okay. Great. Okay. 23 Section XI. We talked about no pending motions, 24 correct? 25 MS. TAN: That is correct.

1	COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Okay. And, Section XII,
2	pending confidentiality motions.
3	MS. TAN: There are five pending
4	confidentiality requests which will be addressed by
5	separate orders.
6	COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Any idea when?
7	MS. TAN: We'll hopefully get it done before
8	the hearing.
9	COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Okay. Thank you.
LO	And Section XIII, post-hearing procedures.
11	MS. TAN: If there are briefs filed, they
L2	should total no more than 40 pages.
L3	COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Section XIV, rulings,
L4	opening statements.
L 5	MR. BUTLER: That's fine.
L6	COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Okay. That brings us to
L7	the end of the draft prehearing order. Any other
L8	comments before we close out today for this particular
L9	docket?
20	MS. KAUFMAN: Commissioner Edgar, I would
21	simply ask to be excused from the 02 docket, as well.
22	COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Okay. Any others? No.
23	Okay. So then similarly, as we did with the previous
24	docket, also I ask you to coordinate with staff, noting
25	that request, and for staff to coordinate that with the
