Dear Mr. Friedman and Mr. Marcelli:

By this letter, the Commission staff requests that Ni Florida, LLC (Ni Florida or utility) provide responses to the following data requests.

- Please provide all available documentation to support the change in the percentage of total corporate overhead allocable to utilities (allocation factor) from the 47.09 percent included in the Utility's filing in Docket No. 100149-WU to the 89.22 percent included in the schedule counsel for Ni Florida handed out at the January 25, 2011 Commission Conference.
- Please provide an itemized list of each component, and its associated dollar amount, that comprises the actual total corporate overhead, by month, for the year ended December 31, 2010.
- For any changes in the total amount of corporate overhead recorded in 2009 compared to the total amount recorded for 2010 related to the hiring of additional employees in 2010, please indicate:
 - the month the new employee was hired; a)
 - the position title; b)
 - the amount of their monthly compensation; c)
 - identify their duties and responsibilities; d)

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- e) identify the duties and responsibilities, if any, the new employee took over from any existing employees;
- f) provide any change in the duties and responsibilities of all existing employees that occurred as a result of the hiring of additional employees; and
- g) identify the specific benefits to Ni Florida's Tamiami customers as a result of the hiring any additional employees.
- 4. Please identify the employees and their respective percentage of time and salary included in the allocation factor of 47.09 percent and identify the employees and their respective percentage of time and salary included in the allocation factor of 89.22 percent. For purposes of this response, please list the assigned duties for all employees and delineate between work related to water and/or wastewater operations and work related to acquisitions or other activities not directly related to operating water and/or wastewater utilities for both 2009 and 2010.
- 5. Please provide the equivalent residential connections (ERCs) for 2010, by month, for each Ni America water and wastewater system. Also provide the total number of ERCs for Ni America for the year ended December 31, 2010.
- 6. For purposes of this request, please see the audit adjustments in Audit Finding 5 and the additional adjustment addressed in Issue 10, on page 17 of the staff recommendation filed January 12, 2011. Please identity all corporate overhead costs for 2010, by month, that are the same or similar to the costs indentified in the above-referenced adjustments related to 2009.
- 7. For any rate relief petition filed by a Ni America subsidiary from January 1, 2010 to date, other than the instant case involving Ni Florida, LLC, please provide the requested and approved amount of allocated corporate overhead recognized in rates. In this response, please include all calculations showing the total amount of corporate overhead before any adjustments for non-utility matters, the total utility-related amount of overhead, the allocation factor(s), and the number of ERCs used in the allocation determination from each case. In addition, please provide a copy of all orders from other Commissions related to the rate relief petitions referenced above.
- 8. Attached is a letter dated January 14, 2011, from Mr. John M.S. Hoefer on behalf of the Ni America subsidiary in South Carolina to Ms. Jocelyn D. Boyd of the Public Service Commission of South Carolina, with the subject line "Notice of Intent to File for Rate Adjustment by Palmetto Utilities, Inc." Please provide the amount of allocated overhead that Palmetto will be requesting in the above-mentioned rate proceeding. In this response, please include all calculations showing the total amount of corporate overhead before any adjustments for non-utility matters, the total utility-related amount of overhead, the allocation factor(s), and the number of ERCs used in the allocation determination.
