### REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

GULF POWER COMPANY ["Gulf Power", "Gulf", or the "Company"], by and through its undersigned attorney and pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, hereby files its request that the Florida Public Service Commission enter an order protecting from public disclosure certain information contained in Schedule 2 of Exhibit HRB-1 to the Direct Testimony of Herbert R. Ball dated March 1, 2011. As grounds for this request, the Company states:

- 1. A portion of the information contained in Schedule 2 of Exhibit HRB-1 to the Direct Testimony of Herbert R. Ball dated March 1, 2011 constitutes proprietary and commercially sensitive information regarding competitive interests and contractual matters of Gulf Power, which, if disclosed to the general public, would cause irreparable harm to Gulf Power. This information is entitled to confidential classification pursuant to section 366.093(3)(d) and (e), Florida Statutes.
- 2. Schedule 2 contains price terms for Gulf Power's coal purchases in 2010. Gulf and other members of the market in which it competes consider such pricing information to be competitively sensitive. Disclosure of this information would adversely affect Gulf's ability to conduct its coal procurement activities to the benefit of its customers. Disclosure of such cost information would also impair Gulf's ability to enter into future contracts for the benefit of its customers.
- 3. The information filed pursuant to this Request is intended to be, and is treated as confidential by Gulf Power and, to the best of this attorney's knowledge, has not been otherwise publicly disclosed.

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4. Submitted as Exhibit "A" is one (1) copy of Schedule 2, on which is highlighted the information for which confidential classification is requested. Exhibit "A" should be treated as confidential pending a ruling on this Request.
