Pursuant to Section 366.093 of the Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, FPL requests confidential classification of certain highlighted information in its Schedule M1 included in the 2010 final true-up testimony and exhibits of Curtis Young.

Based on staff's review, certain highlighted information in FPUC's confidentiality request can be found in FPUC's filings to the Commission with no confidentiality. In staff's opinion, the request does not meet the criteria for confidentiality contained in section 366.093 Florida Statutes. Therefore, staff recommends that the request for confidentiality of certain information included in Document No. 01382-11 be denied.
