## Re: Ten-Year Site Plan - Data Request Regarding Planned Solar Power Plants

Dear Mr. Butler:

By this letter, the Commission staff requests that Florida Power and Light Company provide responses to the following data requests.

1. The 2011 Ten-Year Site Plan shows that, beginning in 2016, the firm capacity purchases from the UPS and SJRPP will no longer be available.
  - a. Please describe or explain what plans, if any, FPL is making or has in place to either extend these contracts or to replace these purchases.
  - b. If this firm capacity cannot be renewed or replaced, what are FPL's plans for the excess transmission capacity that will become available as a result?
2. In its 2011 Ten-Year Site Plan, FPL's Schedule 5 on page 91 shows that after a decline through 2014, the fuel requirements for steam generation increase for the remainder of the planning horizon. Please identify the steam units whose outputs will increase resulting in increased fuel requirements.
3. The 2011 Ten-Year Site Plan describes the need for additional natural gas supply and additional gas transportation capacity. However, no discussion is provided regarding FPL's plans to meet this need. Please explain or describe the steps being taken and the options being considered in order to ensure an adequate supply of natural gas will be available when the modernized units at Cape Canaveral and Riviera Beach become operational.


