On April 19, 2011, AT&T Florida filed a Request for Specified Confidential Classification of certain portions of information listed in Exhibits C and D to its Motion to Dismiss and Response to Easy Telephone's Complaint. AT&T Florida states that the specified information is considered proprietary and confidential business information to Easy Telephone that is not generally available to the public. The information relates to Easy Telephone's competitive interests. Specifically, it relates to past due balances that Easy Telephone owes AT&T Florida and the number of resale lines that Easy Telephone has with AT&T Florida.

I have reviewed the specified information and believe that it meets the requirements for confidential classification pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes (F.S). Therefore, I recommend that it be exempt from the public disclosure requirements of Section 119.07, F.S.
