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## PROCEEDINGS

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Item 7.

MR. MA: Good morning, Commissioners. Victor
Ma with Commission Staff.

Item 7 is Staff's recommendation for Docket Number 110047-EQ. On February 3rd, 2011, PEF filed a petition to the Commission for the approval of a negotiated contract between PEF and Trans World Energy LLC.

Staff's analysis is that the proposed facility, the proposed negotiated contract between PEF and Trans World is cost-effective and recommends that PEF's petition be approved by the Commission. Payments to the proposed negotiated contract are a combination of monthly capacity and energy payments fixed at a specific annual rate per megawatt hour delivered from the generating plant. When compared to PEF's 2010 and 2011 standard offer, the payments to the proposed Trans World facility is estimated to have net savings of \$61.6 million and \$28.5 million respectively.

Staff would note fuel forecasts and analysis for the contract show that should fuel costs reduce dramatically, the proposed facility may have projected net costs of \$2.9 million because the energy payments are fixed per the contract. However, Staff believes

this risk is acceptably small when considering the potential for a much greater economic benefit for PEF's ratepayers. Staff is prepared to answer any questions you may have.

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CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Thank you, Staff.

Commissioner Balbis.

COMMISSIONER BALBIS: Thank you, Mr. Chair. Excuse me. Yeah. I pulled this item because I think it's important to, to point out, you know, a really good project in the fact that we have 40 megawatts of renewable energy that is biomass. And I know that we know, but I don't know how much the public knows that, you know, the largest percentage of renewable energy in Florida is biomass. And so this is an exciting project that, you know, not only will produce savings, you know, up to \$61.6 million to Progress's customers, but again it's a, it's a renewable energy project that will create jobs in Citrus County. And I just wanted to point out that this is a really good project. And, you know, again I want to congratulate Progress Energy and Staff in moving this forward, and with that I would move approval of these issues associated with this project.

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: It's been moved and seconded moving Staff's recommendation on this project. Any further discussion? Seeing none, all in favor, say aye.
