PEF's competitors and those third-parties with whom the Company seeks to contract would be able to change their behavior in the relevant markets or their contractual negotiating positions, respectively, to the detriment of PEF and its customers.

4. Upon receipt of this confidential information, as with all confidential information, strict procedures are established and followed to maintain the confidentiality of the terms of the documents and information provided therein. Such procedures include, but are not limited to, restricting access to the documents and information to only those persons who require it to assist the Company. At no time has PEF publicly disclosed the confidential information contained in the Report; PEF has treated and continues to treat the information contained in the Report as confidential. Nothing has changed since the Commission granted this information confidential treatment of this information to render it stale or public information. Accordingly, the confidential treatment of this information should be continued.
