



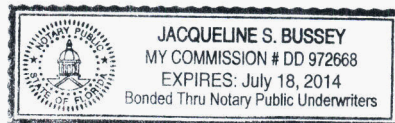

Additionally, certain of these materials contain competitively sensitive information related to certain employees' compensation. Public disclosure of compensation information for particular positions would enable competing employers to meet or beat the compensation offered by FPL, resulting in the loss of talented employees, or conversely, the need to increase the level of compensation already paid in order to retain these employees and attract new talent. The quality of service and the cost of service implications would be detrimental to FPL and its customers. This information is unrelated to employees' compensation, duties, qualifications, or responsibilities. 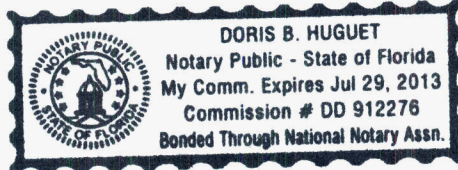
