Dear Ms. Cole:

The U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is currently conducting several rulemakings that could directly affect Florida's electric utilities, including Tampa Electric Company. The potential rules and standards are at various stages of development and include regulations focused on (1) air emissions, including greenhouse gases; (2) cooling water intake and wastewater discharge; and (3) the disposal of coal combustion residues. EPA's proposed rules would affect all existing fossil fuel fired electric generation, including Tampa Electric facilities located at Big Bend, Polk and Bayside Power Stations.

The ongoing EPA rulemakings present significant challenges to the utility industry and will require substantial analysis and planning to develop and implement cost-effective compliance measures. While the ultimate content of the proposed EPA rules and their effective dates are not known with certainty at this time, Tampa Electric will need to contract with outside consultants to, among other things, analyze the proposed rules and develop compliance strategies. These efforts may need to be commenced in 2012 and could include emissions testing, engineering and other analyses.

Given the ongoing nature of the rulemakings, Tampa Electric is in the process of formulating what it will need in order to develop its compliance strategies. Once that is accomplished, Tampa Electric will prepare and submit for Commission consideration a petition addressing the necessary compliance costs.
