RE: Recommendation to Office of the General Counsel - Docket No. 110261-TX – Petition for expedited review of growth code denials by the Number Pooling Administration for the Coral Springs rate center by Sprint Communications Company.

On August 17, 2011, Sprint filed a request for additional numbering resources from the Number Pooling Administrator (NeuStar) for the Coral Springs (PMBHFLMA). Sprint requested a 1,000 block 954 NPA NXX code for Coral Spring rate center. On August 17, 2011, Sprint request for additional numbering resources was denied because it did not meet the utilization criteria.

On August 26, 2011, Sprint filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn NeuStar's decision. In accordance with Commission Order No. PSC-01-1973-PCO-TL, (Docket No. 020087-TL) which approved an expedited process for the NeuStar code denials, staff has examined the Sprint's petition and has determined the following:

- 1) The carrier has demonstrated that it has customers in need of numbering resources;
- 2) The carrier has shown that it will be unable to provide services to these potential customers because of NeuStar's denial of the numbering resources; and
- 3) Customers will not be able to obtain service from the provider of his/her choice because the carrier does not have the numbers available.

Since the three criteria of PSC-01-1973-PCO-TL have been met, please prepare an administrative Proposed Agency Action Order to be issued within seven business days of this memorandum (September 16, 2011), as outlined in the expedited code denial process order. NeuStar should be directed to provide Sprint the needed numbering resources to meet its customer's needs in the Coral Spring rate center. Please allow staff assigned to the docket to review the Order before it is issued. If you have any questions, please call Sakina Deas at (850) 413-6504.
