On lines 42 through 46 in the calculation of the revenue requirements for the EPU asset retirements in 2011, it appears the depreciation expense and property tax expense credits were added to the revenue requirements of the retired assets rather than being used to reduce the revenue requirements. Is it correct that this is an error in the calculation? If not, please explain why.
- Please refer to Attachment B, Revenue Requirements, Page 1 of 42. In calculating the amount 2. of the annual depreciation credit for nuclear on line 42, it appears the (\$108,802) for removal costs and salvage on Page 21 of 42 was not included as a reduction. Is it correct that this is an error in the calculation? If not, please explain why?
- 3. If the above items are errors, please submit a revised Attachment B, Revenue Requirements, Page 1 of 42.
