So with that, we're going to proceed to Docket

Number 110003-GU. Ms. Crawford, are there any preliminary

matters that we need to address before we get to the draft

prehearing order?

MS. CRAWFORD: Staff is not aware of any and none are expected at this time. Again, I would note for the record that St. Joe Natural Gas Company and Peoples Gas System have been excused from the 03 and 04 dockets.

I would also like to point out that it appears that all parties have agreement on all issues. In other words, all issues appear to be stipulated. Noting, however, that OPC takes no position on those issues. And those proposed stipulations are reflected in Sections VIII and X of the draft prehearing order.

commissioner brisé: All right. With that, it's going to make it rather easy this morning on that particular docket, so I will proceed through the draft prehearing order. We will go through this rather quickly. I'll identify the sections. I want parties to let me know

if there are any corrections or changes that need to be made. We will go quickly through a lot of this, so please speak into the mike if you have corrections that we need to make.

Section I, case background. Section II, conduct of proceedings. Section III, jurisdiction. Section IV, procedures for handling confidential information.

Section V, prefiled testimony and exhibits; witnesses.

MS. CRAWFORD: For this section, I would like to note that it appears, again, since there are stipulations on all issues, it does appear that all witnesses may be excused if no Commissioner seeks cross-examination. Staff is in the process of making that confirmation. As soon as it is known, hopefully that can be reflected in the prehearing order once finalized.

COMMISSIONER BRISÉ: Thank you.

Section VI, order of witnesses. Section VII, basic positions. Section VIII, issues and positions.

MS. CRAWFORD: Again, I'd simply note it does appear that there are stipulations on all issues. I'd leave it to the parties if there is any disagreement to that effect.

COMMISSIONER BRISÉ: Section IX, exhibit list.

MS. CRAWFORD: I'd like to note that staff has prepared a comprehensive exhibit list that consists of the

list itself as well as all prefiled testimony and exhibits. Staff has distributed that proposed list to all parties, and we'll present that accordingly at the hearing.

COMMISSIONER BRISÉ: Section X, proposed stipulations.

MS. CRAWFORD: Again, simply noting that it does appear that there are stipulations on issues. However, noting that OPC takes no position.

commissioner BRISÉ: Section XI, pending motions. Section XII, pending confidentiality motions.

MS. CRAWFORD: There are two pending confidentiality requests. Staff will prepare separate orders for those requests.

COMMISSIONER BRISÉ: Thank you.

Section XIII, post-hearing procedures. Section XIV, I guess these are the rulings. Opening statements, I will say, shall be limited to five minutes per party.

And, staff, I don't know if there is any --

MS. CRAWFORD: I would like to note that in the past, given that all of these issues are stipulated, parties have waived opening statements in the 03 and 04 dockets. Perhaps it would be appropriate to look to the parties to see if that might again be accomplished in this docket.
