Enclosed for filing in the above-referenced docket is the response of Grenelefe Resort Utility, Inc. (the "Utility" or "Grenelefe") to Staff's first data request dated October 11, 2011 related to non-potable water service.


(a) An allocation of salaries, payroll taxes, purchased power, management fees, and any other expenses related to non-potable water;

**RESPONSE:** Salaries, payroll taxes, and management fees are allocated one-half to water and one-half to wastewater. Based upon the percentage of non-potable water sales to total water sales would result in an allocation of 22.45% to the non-potable water system.

(b) Identify specific National Association of Regulatory Commissioners (NARUC) account number(s) of any plant items related to non-potable water.

**RESPONSE:** Grenelefe does not differentiate non-potable water system assets from total water assets.
