The Commission, in order to accomplish the requirements of section 120.74(1), F.S., reviewed, repealed or modified our rules over the period of August 2009 through November 2011 in order to ensure that our rules are correct and comply with statutory requirements. The rules on the attached list were repealed or amended during this time period to further the following statutory goals:

- (a) To identify and correct deficiencies;
- (b) To clarify and simplify rules;
- (c) To delete obsolete or unnecessary rules;
- (d) To delete rules that are redundant of statutes;
- (e) To seek to improve efficiency, reduce paperwork, or decrease costs to government and the private sector;
- (f) To promote efficiency, reduce paperwork, or decrease costs to government and the private sector through coordination with other agencies;
- (g) To reduce the impact on small business while meeting the stated objectives of rules through amendment or repeal.

In repealing or amending these rules, the methods listed in Section 120.54(3)(b)2.a.(I) - (V) were considered in order to reduce the impact on small businesses. A copy of the rule summary and statement of facts and circumstances justifying the rule amendment or repeal has been included for each of the rules listed. These documents are taken from the Certification of Adoption submitted by the Commission to the Secretary of State. The information therein provides some background on the effects of the rule amendments or repeals, including the economic impact on small business.

25-12.008, New, Reconstructed or Converted Facilities, is amended to delete references to filed plans required by repealed rule 25-12.039. The deleted reference was obsolete. The Code of Federal Regulation citation is updated.

25-12.022, Requirements for Distribution System Valves, is amended to clarify the requirements for sectionalizing valves only, not all valves. The rule was amended to give a distance exception for location of valves if they are physically impractical to install in areas like river crossing and closed interstate highways.

25-12.027, Welder Qualifications, is amended to update the references to the current standard and code for welding on pipelines. The former citations were outdated.

25-12.040, Leak Surveys, Procedures and Classifications, is amended to clarify the rule's intent that cleared gas leaks are repaired.

Rule 25-22.061 Docket No. 100062-07 SUMMARY OF RULE 25-22.061, Stay Pending Judicial Review, is amended to delete provisions concerning automatic review pending judicial review granted to public entities filing of a notice of appeal in administrative actions under Chapter 120, F.S. The amendments state the factors which the Commission may consider in determining whether to grant a stay, under what conditions the Commission may condition a stay, and list the factors that the Commission may consider in setting an interest rate when granting a stay conditioned upon the posting of a bond or corporate undertaking. The rule clarifies that motions for stay shall be heard by those Commissioners who were on the deciding panel for the order being appealed.

SUMMARY OF HEARINGS ON THE RULE

No hearing was requested and none was held.

FACTS AND CIRCUMSTANCES JUSTIFYING THE RULE

25-22.061, Stay Pending Judicial Review, is amended for consistency with Fla. R. App. P. 9.310, which has been amended to provide that the timely filing of a notice of appeal does not operate as a stay pending judicial review in administrative actions under Chapter 120, F.S., when the state, any public officer in an official capacity, board, commission, or other public body seeks review. The amendments clarify the factors which the Commission may consider in determining whether to grant a stay, under what conditions the Commission may condition a stay, and amend the factors that the Commission may consider in setting an interest rate when granting a stay conditioned upon the posting of a bond or corporate undertaking. The rule clarifies that motions for stay shall be heard by those Commissioners who were on the deciding panel for the order being appealed.

Rules 25-22.103, 25-22.1035, 25-22.105, 25-22.107 Docket No. 090502-OT

SUMMARY OF RULE

The rule revisions place the Commission in the role of being its own Official Reporter, as of January 1, 2010. This is implemented through the Commission's Web site which provides an electronic database of the Commission's orders. Prior orders are located in the FPSC Reporter, published by FALR. Rule 25-22.103, Orders Indexed, is repealed because there is no need for orders to be "indexed" when an electronic database is used instead; Rule 25-22.1035, Designation of Official Reporter, is amended to make the Commission's Web site the Official Reporter from January 2010 forward; Rule 25-22.107, Plan for Making Orders Available to the Public, is amended to state that copies of orders are maintained electronically at the Commission's Web site; Rule 25-22.105, System for Indexing Orders, is amended to refer to the Commission's electronic database on the Commission's Web site. The amendments also refer to the advanced search feature of orders.

SUMMARY OF HEARINGS ON THE RULE

No hearing was requested and none was held.

FACTS AND CIRCUMSTANCES JUSTIFYING THE RULE

The Florida Public Service Commission currently has an electronic database of its orders. Thus, there is no longer a need for the orders to be "indexed" and published when an electronic database is used. There should be benefits in saving staff time to reproduce and mail the orders to the publisher and the associated reproduction and mailing costs. Also, consumers, utilities and business entitles will know the orders are online and they may obtain access without subscribing to a publication.

SUMMARY OF RULE

These rules are repealed that relate to rate-of-return regulated local exchange companies. There are no longer rate-of-return regulated telecommunication companies. The requirements listed by the rules include accounting rules, reporting and minimum filing requirements for rate cases.

SUMMARY OF HEARINGS ON THE RULE

No hearing was requested and none was held.

FACTS AND CIRCUMSTANCES JUSTIFYING THE RULE

There are no longer any telecommunication rate-of-return regulated local exchange companies. Thus, there is no need for these rules that address such companies.

SUMMARY OF THE RULE

Rules 24-4,0185, 25-4.022, and 25.4.023 pertain to record and reporting requirements for local exchange telecommunication companies (LECs); Rules 25-4.0345, 25-4.036, 25-4.038, 25-4.040, and 25-4.041 partain to management requirements for LECs; Rules 25-4.066, 25-4.070, 25-4.071, 25-4.072, 25-4.073, 25-4.074, 25-4.078, 25-4.079, 25-4.081, 25-4.084, and 25-4.085 pertain to service provisions for LECs; 25-4.088, 25-4.089, 25-4.090, 25-4.091, 25-4.092, 25-4.093, 25-4.094, 25-4.095, 25-4.096, and 25-4.097 pertain to telephone underground extension requirements for LECs; Rules 25-4.107, 25-4.109, 25-4.111, 25-4.114, 25-4.115, and 25-4.117 pertain to customer relations requirements for LECs; and Rules 25-4.202 and 25-4.210 pertain to LEC service evaluations and investigations. SUMMARY OF RULE

The rule codifies Lifeline service eligibility requirements and requirements that eligible

telecommunications carriers (ETCs) must follow when offering Lifeline service. Such requirements include offering toll blocking and toll limitation service, and number-portability free of charge. Additional requirements address Link-Up service, service deposits, noticing of impending termination of Lifeline service, timing of the Lifeline credit, distribution of Lifeline information, and quarterly reporting requirements.

SUMMARY OF HEARINGS ON THE RULE

No hearing was requested and none was held.

FACTS AND CIRCUMSTANCES JUSTIFYING THE RULE

To codify current Lifeline requirements and to implement requirements that will facilitate enrollment in the

program.

SUMMARY OF RULE

Rule 25-4.083 is amended to require local providers to meet the requirements of the Federal Preferred Carrier Freeze rule, and duplicative provisions of the rule are deleted. In addition, provisions in Sec. 364.603 are implemented.

SUMMARY OF HEARINGS ON THE RULE

An agenda conference was held September 15, at which the written comments provided by FCTA and incumbent local exchange carriers were considered. The Commission voted not to make any change to the proposed rule.

FACTS AND CIRCUMSTANCES JUSTIFYING THE RULES

Rule 25-4.083 is amended to require local providers to meet the requirements of the Federal Preferred Carrier Freeze rule, and duplicative provisions of the rule are deleted. Thus, the rule is streamlined. In addition, language to implement Sec. 364.603, F.S., is retained that provides the Preferred Carrier Preeze must be at no charge to the subscriber.

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Railes 25-4.0185, 25-4.066, 25-4.070, 25-4.073, and 25-4.110 Docket No. 080641-TP

SUMMARY OF RULES

Rule 25-4.0185 is amended to make required technical changes to Division names and form numbers, to delete reference to Schedule 16, to specify that Schedules 2, 3, 11, and 15 apply to basic residential service only, and to delete instructions concerning Schedules 19. Form PSC/SSC 28 is incorporated by reference into Rule 25-4.0185, and has been amended consistent with the amendments to Rules 25-4.066, 25-4.070, and 25-4.073.

Rule 25-4.066 is amended to apply to basic residential service only, to replace the term "filed tariff" and "tariff" with the term "schedules" or "schedule," to delete certain requirements concerning facilities' design, reporting requirement language, and customer notice, and to amend companies' reporting method from exchange based to access line based.

Rule 25-4.070, is amended to apply to basic residential service only, to identify service restoration requirements as "service standards," to require clearing of 90% interrupted service and service affecting trouble reports within the required time period, to delete unnecessary provisions, to change the reporting method from exchange based to rural and urban access line based, and to delete requirements concerning repeat trouble.

Rule 25-4.073 is amended to apply to basic residential service only, to change answer time requirements, including amending the rule to require 90 percent of calls to business and repair offices to be answered within 90 seconds, to require calls offered using IVRU to be answered within 30 seconds of last digit dialed, to give the option of transferring to a live attendant within the first 60 seconds of the message, to require the live attendant to give assistance within 90 seconds of transfer, to delete use of answering time studies, and to delete reference to a reporting form.

Rule 25-4.110 is amonded to require local providers to comply with FCC Truth-in-Billing Requirements, to delete rule provisions duplicative of statute or federal requirements or which are obsolete or contact to recent statutory changes.

SUMMARY OF HEARINGS ON THE RULES

A hearing was held on August 18, 2009, at which the Commission considered written commentary by incumbent local exchange companies on the rules. The Commission voted to make set to have a set of the set of the

proposed rules based on those written comments. The changes appeared in the September 4, 2009 edition of the Florida Administrative Weekly.

FACTS AND CIRCUMSTANCES JUSTIFYING THE RULES

Rule 25-4.0185 is amended to make required technical changes for accuracy. The requirement to file Schedule 16 is deleted as unnecessary. The rule is amended to state that Schedules 2, 3, 11, and 15 apply to basic residential service only, consistent with the amendments to Rules 25-4.066, 25-4.070, and 25-4.083. Form PSC/SSC 28 is amended consistent with the amendments to Rules 25-4.066, 25-4.070, and 25-4.073. These changes comport with the regulatory streamlining focus of this rulemaking.

Rule 25-4.066 is amended to apply to basic residential service only and to replace the term "filed tariff" and "tariff" with the term "schedules or "schedule," which is consistent with statutory changes to Chapter 364, F.S. The rule is amended to delete requirements concerning facilities' design because these standards and conditions are required to be in schedules. The rule is amended to delete as unnecessary the requirement for a company to leave notice if unable to gain admittance to a customer's premises. Amending the rule to change the reporting method from exchange based to access line based gives companies more flexibility in dispatching outside technicians. The rule is amended to delete reporting requirement language duplicative of form instructions. These changes comport with the regulatory streamlining focus of this rulemaking.

Rule 25-4.070 is amended to apply to basic residential service only which is consistent with statutory changes to Chapter 364, F.S. Amending the rule to change the reporting method from exchange based to access line based gives companies more flexibility in dispatching outside technicians. Characterizing service restoration requirements as service standards is consistent with Commission practice. Repeat trouble requirements are deleted as unnecessary. These changes comport with the regulatory streamlining focus of this rulemaking.

Rule 25-4.073, is amended to apply to basic residential service only, which is consistent with statutory changes to Chapter 364, F.S. Increasing answer time requirements is intended to allow companies flexibility in managing their call centers, could result in cost savings to companies, and allows acceptable amounts of time to callers. The rule requirement that subscribers not using IVRU be transferred to a live attendant within 20 seconds is deleted as obsolete. Answering time studies are deleted as unnecessary and duplicative of other data Subranded to the Commission by companies. These changes comport with the regulatory streamlining focus of the fulentiaking. 77 ERT UP STAT

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Rule 25-4.110 is amended to require local providers to comply with FCC Truth-in-Billing Requirements, to delete rule provisions duplicative of statute or federal requirements or which are obsolete. The rule was amended to delete the requirement that the bill insert or bill message be submitted to the Commission, consistent with recent statutory changes. These changes comport with the regulatory streamlining focus of this rulemaking.

Rule Nos. 25-24,516 and 25-24,630 Docket No. 060476-TL

SUMMARY OF RULE

The amendments remove the price caps for operator services and replace references to "tariffs" with "schedules."

All provisions of this rule have been included within the newer Rules 25-30.115, F.A.C., Uniform System of Accounts for Water and Wastewater Utilities and 25-30.110, F.A.C., Records and Reports; Annual Reports. Rule 25-10.111, F.A.C., requires water and wastewater utilities to bill customers at regular intervals; contains various provisions for prorating less than full bill amounts; and requires a minimum of 20 days before a bill is considered delinquent. All of the provisions of this rule have been subsumed by Rule 25-30.335, F.A.C., Customer Billing. Repeal of Rules 25-10.026 and 25-10.111 will prevent confusion or conflict with the more detailed rules in Chapter 25-30, and will eliminate redundant provisions which are no longer in use.

SUMMARY OF HEARINGS ON THE RULE

No hearing was requested and none was held.

FACTS AND CIRCUMSTANCES JUSTIFYING THE RULE

Rule 25-10.026, F.A.C. requires water and wastewater utilities to maintain records in accordance with the NARUC system of accounts and to maintain those records in an office within the State of Florida. All provisions of this rule have been included within the newer Rules 25-30.115, F.A.C., Uniform System of Accounts for Water and Wastewater Utilities and 25-30.110, F.A.C., Records and Reports; Annual Reports. Rule 25-10.111, F.A.C., requires water and wastewater utilities to bill customers at regular intervals; contains various provisions for prorating less than full bill amounts; and requires a minimum of 20 days before a bill is considered delinquent. All of the provisions of this rule have been subsumed by Rule 25-30.335, F.A.C., Customer Billing. Repeal of Rules 25-10.026 and 25-10.111 will prevent confusion or conflict with the more detailed rules in Chapter 25-30, and will eliminate redundant provisions which are no longer in use.



Rule 25-30.0371 Docket No. 100338-WS

SUMMARY OF RULE

The proposed rule amendments separate cases involving negative acquisitions adjustments in water and wastewater into two groups--those in which the difference between purchase price and net book value is greater than 50 percent, and those in which the difference is 50 percent or less. If the purchase price is 50 percent or less of net book value, half of the negative acquisition adjustment is amortized over seven years, and half over the remaining life of the assets purchased. This amortization provides a greater sharing with customers and puts downward pressure on rate base.

SUMMARY OF HEARINGS ON THE RULE

No hearing was requested and none was held.

FACTS AND CIRCUMSTANCES JUSTIFYING THE RULE

The proposed changes are designed to give more of the benefit of a negative acquisition adjustment to the ratepayers by increasing the amortization period of the acquisition adjustment, especially for those cases in which the systems are purchased at a significant discount. In April, 2009, a case came before the Commission involving the sale of a relatively new utility at a large discount. There was a situation where there was not be as great a need to encourage the purchase of a utility. Thus, these revisions are aimed at balancing the goal of encouraging acquisition with the goal of allowing ratepayers to share in the benefit of a negative acquisition adjustment.
