

Re: Jurisdictional status of International Villas water system in Marion County

Dear Ms. Ortiz:

Your e-mail to Mr. Dale DeSimone on October 13, 2011 that stated Mr. Gupta does not intend to charge the residents of International Villas for water service was forwarded to me by Vicki Prendergast. Because there will be no specific charge made for water service, this water system is exempt from Public Service Commission jurisdiction pursuant to Section 367.022(5), Florida Statutes, which states in part:

The following are not subject to regulation by the commission as a utility nor are they subject to the provisions of this chapter, except as expressly provided:

(5) Landlords providing service to their tenants without specific compensation for the service.

The water operation still meets the classification as a public utility, but is exempt from Commission regulation. If the circumstances should change, meaning if customers are to be charged for water service, please advise the Commission of this intent so that our staff can investigate.
