Pursuant to Rule 25-6.0185, Florida Administrative Code, electric utilities that own or control electric generation facilities are required to file a long term energy emergency plan and periodic updates with the Florida Public Service Commission (Commission) and the Florida Reliability Coordinating Council. The affected utilities are required to review their plans every three calendar years and either submit a revised plan to the Commission for approval or provide a letter indicating the adequacy of the existing plan. The Commission last approved the utilities plans in Order No. PSC-09-0232-PAA-EM, issued April 15, 2009, in Docket No. 090047-EM.

On December 6, 2011, Progress Energy Florida, Inc. filed Document No. 08792, in Docket No. 090047-EM. As mentioned previously, utilities are required to review their plans every three calendar years and either submit a revised plan to the Commission for approval, or provide a letter indicating the adequacy of the existing plan. The document filed on December 6<sup>th</sup> by Progress represents the company's actions as required by the statue to review its existing energy emergency plans and file a revised plan. The document does not relate to the events that occurred in Docket No. 090047-EM, which is closed, and should be moved into the recently established Docket No. 110316-EM.
