Dear Ms. Cole:

On July 31, 2012 Utilities Inc. of Florida ("Company") filed its test year request letter, which was subsequently approved by the Chairman. The Company has discovered an error in the explanation of pro-forma plant additions and the correct pro-forma plant additions are set forth herein. I apologize for the oversight.

Since the Company's last rate proceeding, the Company has made significant investments in plant and equipment in its water and wastewater systems, primarily replacement of capital assets such as pumps, motors, mains, service laterals, water meters, water treatment equipment, hydropneumatic tanks, and instrumentation and monitoring equipment. Within that same period of time, there have been no major changes in operational methods.

The Company proposes to make the following major pro forma plant additions (with estimates in parenthesis):

Seminole County:

Park Ridge Water Main and Valve Replacement	(\$350,000)
Park Ridge WTP Electrical Improvements	(\$ 80,000)
Park Ridge Emergency Interconnect w/Sanford	(\$ 65,000)
Ravenna Park Force Main Replacement	(\$ 70,000)

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Ravenna Park Reduction of I&I	(\$120,000)
Ravenna Park WTP Electrical Improvements	(\$100,000)
Phillips WTP Electrical Improvements	(\$ 80,000)
Weathersfield WTP Electrical Improvements	(\$ 50,000)
Weathersfield Valve Replacement	(\$ 56,000)
Pasco County:	
Summertree Well 13 Hydro Tank Replacement	(\$ 50,000)
Orangewood/Buena Vista TP Water Main Rplc	(\$300,000)
Pinellas County:	
Lake Tarpon Water Main, Laterals & Meters	(\$300,000)
Marion County:	
Crownwood Effluent Disposal	(\$ 50,000)

The pro formas are non growth-related.
