MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE TESTIMONY OUT OF TIME


The Staff of the Florida Public Service Commission (Staff) hereby moves the Prehearing Officer for leave to file out of time the Staff testimony of Witnesses Jeffery Small, Ileana Piedra, and Bety Maitre, regarding the financial audits they conducted in the above-stated matter. In support of its motion, the Staff states as follows:

Staff inadvertently neglected to prepare the audit testimony in time for filing Thursday, June 20, 2013, but is prepared to file the testimony Friday, June 21, 2013. Staff contacted all parties in the case to indicate that the testimony would be filed on June 21, and asked the parties to inform them if any party objected to the filing out of time. Florida Power & Light Company and Duke Energy Florida, Inc. indicated that they do not object, and the Intervenors have not contacted Staff with any objections. The scheduled time for filing testimony is not a jurisdictional deadline, and the one day delay will not harm any party.

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
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
