DESCRIPTION: GPC (McGee) - (CONFIDENTIAL) Portions of responses to the Office of Public Counsel's 5th Request for Production of Documents (No. 92) by Gulf Power Company.

Pursuant to Section 366.093 of the Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Gulf Power Company (GPC) requests confidential classification of certain highlighted information on Document No. 05828-13. This memo addresses only the information contained in GPC's responses to the Office of Public Counsel's (OPC) fifth request for production of documents, number 92.

Staff has reviewed GPC's confidentiality request. GPC's response to OPC's fifth request for production of documents, number 92 contains presentations made by GPC to certain credit rating agencies that includes forward looking financial information, the disclosure of which could harm the competitive interests of the company. In staff's opinion, the request meets the criteria for confidentiality set forth in section 366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes. Therefore, staff recommends that GPC's request for confidentiality of GPC's response to OPC's fifth request for production of documents, number 92, contained in Document No. 05828-13 be approved.
