Mr. Brise –

Attached, please find Consolidated Services of Hendry & Collier, LLC's 2013 Annual report for the above referenced water and wastewater certificates. As clearly indicated in the Annual Report, there has not been any activity within the certificated utility during 2013.

In support of our application, we notified the PSC that our request for certification was being made in conjunction with long-term planning efforts being advanced in accordance with Chapter 163.3245 F.S. The corresponding sector plan (known as Southwest Hendry County Sector Plan) was "transmitted" by Hendry County on December 11th, 2013, and has been reviewed by the State during a "State Coordinated Review Process" (Amendment 14-1SP). While the sector plan has made significant advancements, the proposal will not likely obtain final approval until early summer of 2014. As a result, no service is planned, nor are any infrastructure improvements being contemplated prior to the adoption of the Sector Plan by the Department of Economic Opportunity.

We look forward to the approval of the Sector Plan, and to presenting the Public Service Commission with the details of any resulting activity planned within Consolidated Services of Hendry & Collier, LLC.

If there are any questions or clarifications regarding our attached Annual Report, I look forward to meeting with your staff.


