Thank you for your customer complaint in which you expressed concerns regarding Charlie Creek Utilities, LLC's (Charlie Creek) application for a rate increase. To ensure that the Commission staff and the Commissioners have knowledge of your concerns, your complaint information has been placed in the correspondence section of the docket file for all to review.

The Commission's staff makes a recommendation regarding the overall quality of service provided by a utility after evaluating: (1) the quality of the utility's product; (2) the operating conditions of the utility's facilities; and, (3) the utility's attempt to address customers' satisfaction. As part of this evaluation Commission staff reviews sanitary surveys, outstanding citations, violations, and consent orders on file with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP). Commission staff additionally reviews complaints regarding secondary water quality standards for a five year period and considers customer comments and complaints. Secondary water standards regulate debris in water as well as contaminants that may impact the taste odor, and color of drinking water.

Commission staff's recommendation additionally addresses unaccounted for water which is all water produced that is not sold, metered, or accounted for in the records of the utility. Unaccounted for water typically results from water lost due to line leaks or inaccurate customer meters. Based on staff's review, described in the recommendation, the Utility's unaccounted for water is not excessive.
