Request for Confidential Classification for document No. 07058-2017

On August 14, 2017, Florida City Gas (FCG), d/b/a city Gas Company of Florida filed a request for confidential classification for Document No. 07058-2017. This document contains the executed amended and restated gas transportation agreement (GTA). The information in the document for which FCG seeks confidential treatment relates to customer specific information regarding rates, terms, forecasted gas transportation volumes and revenues, and conditions of service arrangements from which the quantities could be arithmetically determined and could be used by others to gain unfair competitive advantage in the market. Staff reviewed the document and concurs with FCG that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Sections 366.093(3) (d) and (e), Florida Statutes (F.S.), whereby disclosure of the information would harm the competitive business operations of FCG.

Therefore, staff recommends that the request by FCG for confidential classification of the Document No. 07058-2017 be approved. Staff notes that the petitioner also stated that Section 366.093(3)(a), F.S., would apply to the information; however, staff did not evaluate the applicability of this statutory provision since the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Sections 366.093(3)(d) and (e), F.S.
