AMENDMENT NO. 1
TO THE
INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT FOR THE STATE OF FLORIDA
BETWEEN
GTC, INC. d/b/a CONSOLIDATED COMMUNICATIONS
AND
BRIGHT HOUSE NETWORKS INFORMATION SERVICES (FLORIDA), LLC

This Amendment No. 1 (this "Amendment") shall be deemed effective on the date approved by the Florida Public Service Commission or otherwise allowed to go into effect by operation of law (the "Amendment Effective Date") by and between Consolidated Communications of Florida Company, formerly known as GTC, Inc. and doing business as Consolidated Communications ("Consolidated"), a Florida corporation with offices at 5 Davis Farm Road, Portland, ME 041031, and Bright House Networks Information Services (Florida), LLC ("BHNIS(FL)"), a Delaware limited liability company with offices at 12405 Powerscourt Drive, St. Louis, MO 63131. Consolidated and BHNIS(FL) may be hereinafter referred to individually as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties". This Amendment covers only the services addressed herein that Consolidated and BHNIS(FL) provide in their operating territories in the state of Florida.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Consolidated and BHNIS(FL) are Parties to an interconnection agreement under Sections 251 and 252 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (the "Act") effective October 29, 2007 (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to amend the Agreement to provide for BHNIS(FL)'s provision of services and the exchange of traffic between the Parties in LATA 450.

AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT

1. The Agreement is amended to incorporate the terms and conditions set forth in this Amendment, all of which shall apply to and be a part of the Agreement (hereinafter referred to as the "Amended Agreement") notwithstanding any other term or condition of the Amended Agreement, a Consolidated Tariff or a Consolidated Statement of Generally Available Terms and Conditions ("SGAT").
2. Section 1.1 of the Interconnection Attachment to Appendix A to the Agreement is amended by deleting the first sentence and replacing it with the following:

This Interconnection Attachment sets forth specific terms and conditions for network interconnection arrangements between MCI and ILEC for the purpose

of the exchange of IntraLATA Traffic and Local/EAS Traffic that is originated by an End User Customer of one Party and is terminated to an End User Customer of the other Party, where End User Customers are physically located in the same LATA or in the same mandatory local calling area as defined and specified in ILEC's tariff.

3. Section 1.1 of the Interconnection Attachment to Appendix A to the Agreement is further amended by deleting the last two (2) sentences.
4. Section 2.3 of the Interconnection Attachment to Appendix A to the Agreement is amended by deleting it in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

The Parties agree to only route IntraLATA Traffic and Local/EAS Traffic over the dedicated facilities between their networks. InterLATA Traffic shall be routed in accordance with Telcordia Traffic Routing Administration instructions and is not a provision of this Agreement. The Parties shall assume that IntraLATA Traffic and Local/EAS Traffic originated by or terminated to the Parties' End User Customers is roughly balanced between the Parties unless and until traffic studies indicate otherwise. Accordingly, the Parties agree reciprocal compensation would be de minimus and, therefore, no billing will be performed for terminating reciprocal compensation on a going forward basis for IntraLATA Traffic or Local/EAS Traffic unless otherwise agreed to by both Parties.

5. Section 5.1 of the Agreement is amended by substituting the following for the addresses for notices to the Parties:

6. Except as expressly set forth herein, the terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect without change.
