Dear Ms. Helton:

The current issue of the Florida Administrative Weekly includes a Notice of Proposed Rule Development concerning rule 25-22.036, stating that the Public Service Commission intends to repeal subsection (3) of the rule. See 26 Fla. Admin. Weekly 1723-24 (April 14, 2000). The notice states that if timely requested and not deemed unnecessary by the Commission, a rule development workshop will be held at 9:30 a.m. on May 2.

As you know, our client, Florida Power & Light Company (FP&L), challenged rule 25-22.036(3) at the Division of Administrative Hearings. The rule challenge is now on appeal at the First District Court of Appeal. See Florida Power & Light Company v. Public Service Commission, Case No. 1D99-4552. All briefs have been filed in the case, and a request for oral argument is pending.

Given the rule challenge and pending appellate proceedings, FP&L has a significant interest in rule 25-22.036(3) and in the staff's reasons for proposing its repeal. FP&L, through this letter, requests that the rule development workshop be held on May 2, 2000, so that issues relating to the proposed repeal can be discussed.

Thank you for your attention to this request. We look forward to seeing you on May 2.
