This letter is regarding the current rate increase for water and sewer at Deer Creek RV Park.

I understand the need for a rate increase. I have 2 concerns:

- 1. The amount of the increase (266%) seems excessive, to say the least.
- 2. Currently the cost of operating and maintaining the sewer lift station is not being fairly shared by all users.

Mockingbird Ridge, Regal Ridge, Fawn Ridge, and the north end commercial businesses (including the Florida tax collection building) are not contributing to these costs.

I ask that the rate increase be reasonable, perhaps 50%.

Also, I would ask the PSC to allow Deer Creek to bill all entities that use our sewer system an appropriate fee to reflect their use of this system.
