Subject: Tentative settlement of FPUC storm cost recovery and depreciation dockets

Keith – This email is to confirm our conversation tonight that OPC and FPUC have reached a tentative agreement to settle FPUC's Hurricane Michael storm recovery docket and their depreciation docket. We are putting the agreement into writing now and will try to file on Friday, or Monday at the latest. The accompanying tariff sheets will be filed a few days later. OPC and FPUC would respectively request that the Pre-Hearing Conference scheduled for this Friday, August 28, be cancelled. Both OPC and FPUC want to utilize the next couple of days to work on drafting the agreement and getting it filed as soon as practical. In addition, we respectfully request that the schedule for submitting cross-examination documents (which is next Tuesday, September 1) also be cancelled. Lastly, OPC and FPUC respectfully request that the hearing dates for these dockets (which are September 8-10) be retained and the settlement be taken up on one of those three days. Both parties commit to work together with staff to provide whatever additional information or documentation staff requests in an expeditious manner in order for the agreement to be considered at that time.
