Then we were told power lines would be put underground but we're not included. Next we were told the trees between the houses where the power lines are would be cut back.

Only certain streets have been done but not ours. So once again we loss power on a clear night when a tree branch fell on the main power line.

I live on social security and these increases are a hardship. I'm requesting that you modify all four storm protection plans due to their failure to meet key provisions of PSC Rule 25-6-030.
