Dear Commission Clerk:

The Woods Utility Company (The Woods) hereby submits its action pursuant to Order No. PSC-2020-0087-PAA-WS (SARC Order), issued on March 25, 2020. The SARC Order stated: "The Utility shall file an action plan with this Commission detailing how it will address excessive lead and copper levels six months after the Final Order is issued in this docket."

The Woods "action plan" to come into compliance was/is as follows:

- 1. Install a sequesterant agent AquaGold treatment on water system Complete.
- 2. Have AquaGold manufacture representative on-site to assist operator in dialing in the appropriate dosage Complete.
- 3. Monitoring of appropriate phosphate limits Ongoing testing equipment purchased and continues to be utilized.
- 4. Request approval from FDEP on revised lead and copper testing plan Approval received.
- 5. Assist customers in taking the proper testing at homes Complete.
- 6. Continue semi-annual lead and copper testing per FDEP requirement Complete.
- 7. Obtain consecutive lead and copper sample results below allowed level Complete.
- 8. Request return to reduced sampling Pending.

Once reduced sampling is approved, no further action is necessary or required. The Woods will continue monitor per FDEP requirements.

The SARC Order also stated: "The Utility shall file status reports with this Commission detailing the actions it has taken to meet the DEP's requirements and its engagement efforts with its customers and with the Office of Public Counsel."

Concerning the engagement, The Woods had initially planned to conduct an in person meeting with its customers and OPC. However, due to the COVID-19 pandemic and meeting restrictions this has not occurred. Customer complaints have reduced and past FPSC customer meetings

reflect historical low attendance from The Woods' customers. The Woods remains open to any further engagement with OPC and its customers.
