This is regarding Tampa Electric seeking approval for rate adjustment, docket #20210034-EI.

For the standard residential rate (RS) they want to increase the basic service charge of \$15.05 per month (which is \$0.485 per day, 31-day month) to \$0.70 per day (which is \$21.70 per month, 31-day month). That is about a 44% increase. That is way too much. I don't know of anyone who has received a 44% pay increase.

Then the energy and demand charge for the first 1000 kWh is going from \$0.05225 per kWh to \$0.06600 per kWh. That is a 26% increase. Again, that is way too much.

The additional kWh charge is increasing 23% from \$0.06225 kWh to \$0.07600 kWh. This is also too much.

I know everything has increased in cost, but let's not pile more on to the already broken bank.
