While FPL rates per kwt are competitive with the rest of the country, due to high usage due to heat/climate change, our kw usage is going up year over year. And avg 1000 kwt used to be what we used but now we use double that, even with raising thermostat and getting energy efficient storm windows and appliances. These rate increases are too high.
