D. STATEMENT OF BASIC POSITION:

The appropriate over (under) recovery amounts and purchased gas adjustment factors are shown in the company's positions on Issues 1 - 5.

E. STATEMENT OF ISSUES AND POSITIONS:

ISSUE 1: What is the final purchased gas adjustment true-up amount for the period January, 2020 through December, 2020?

SJNG's Position: \$38,770 under-recovery.

ISSUE #2: What is the actual/estimated purchased gas adjustment true-up amount for the period of January 2021 through December 2021?

SJNG's Position: \$83,782 over-recovery.

ISSUE #3: What is the total purchased gas adjustment true-up amount to be **refunded** during the period of January **2022** through December **2022**?

SJNG's Position: \$45,013 over-recovery

ISSUE #4: What is the levelized purchased gas adjustment recovery (cap) factor for the period January, **2022** through December, **2022**?

SJNG's Position: 61.70 cents per therm recovery (cap) factor

ISSUE #5: What should be the effective date of the new purchased gas adjustment charge for billing purposes?

SJNG's Position: The effective date for the new purchased gas adjustment charge should be January 1, **2022**.

ISSUE #6: Should the Commission approve the revised tariff reflecting the new purchased gas adjustment charge determined to be appropriate in the proceeding?

SJNG's Position: Yes. The Commission should approve the revised tariff reflecting the new purchased gas adjustment charge determined to be appropriate in the proceeding.

ISSUE #7: Should this docket be closed?
