There was a perfectly good water plant on LGI and Mr. Boyer obtained approval for water service to be supplied from the mainland resulting in our water bill being more than quadrupled. The projected costs for sewer service are over the moon and very questionable. We are retired and on fixed incomes. Again, please deny the proposed project.
