Good morning,

I am sending this email in reference to the proposed LGI Sewer Project. I have several questions regarding the need and installation of a sewer system on LGI.

- Has the county conducted a survey of the home owners to see if the majority of the residents want a septic system?
- Is there a need for a septic system because of an impact on the environment? If so where is the survey to prove this and has it been submitted to the residents as proof?
- Has the county submitted the proposed septic system for 3 bids as most projects are done (City, County, State, and Federal generally required)?

I have concerns when a "profit seeking entity" is pushing for a project in which the entity will receive a long term benefit (payments). Further, the entity involved in pushing this project has a past history which involves criminal activity as it has been relayed to me.

Lastly, should the county decide to proceed with this project, at the cost of the residents, I would suggest the county offer a discount on each owners tax bill until the amount (the cost seems to fluctuate into the \$13,000 to \$20,000 range) has been offset. Additionally, the cost of the monthly service should be evaluated yearly and NO flat fee be assessed monthly regardless of usage (water bill currently is setup this way meaning each resident pays for water at times they do not use).

Thank you in advance for voicing my concerns since I will be working and unable to attend the hearings.
