As a homeowner on Palm Island since January 1994 and a resident since August 1998 I want to thank you for your evaluation of the current proposal to install a waste water system on Palm Island. I am a participant in the PIE Batch Pump-Out program and have had good reviews to date on the condition of my system. We are in a HOA community of 12 private homes of which 2 have had their septic fields and tanks replaced and a third home is planned to be built with a new system. Also there are 5 new systems either in progress or completed along Gulf Blvd in our vicinity.

The impact of development of a waste water system on such a unique community as Palm Island with limited access with a ferry already heavily used would be devastating. Retrofit of a system which just removes waste water seems an unjustified hardship for the already built homes. Surely there's a better way to manage the effectiveness of existing technology without destroying our Island.
