Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) filed a first request for extension of confidential classification of certain information provided in response to the Office of Public Counsel's (OPC) fourth request for production of documents (POD), Nos. 25-27. FPL requests confidentiality under Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S., citing "the confidential business information includes information related to competitive interests. The disclosure of this information would impair the competitive business of FPL." In addition, staff believes the information should remain confidential due to security measures, systems, and procedures, which fall under Section 366.093(c), F.S.

The information for which FPL seeks confidentiality can be described as system maps with component information, substation floodwall construction plans, and substation maps with information about potential flooding at certain elevations. Staff has reviewed the information that FPL has filed, as well as its confidentiality request, and believes the information that is the subject of the request meets the criteria for confidentiality under the sections requested.
