On April 3, 2025, Duke Energy Florida (DEF or Company) filed an amended request for confidential treatment of Document No. 02631-2025. This document contains maps and addresses of pad-mounted transformer locations from DEF's flood mitigation phases.

In its request for confidentiality, DEF contends that disclosure of this information would harm the security of DEF's grid, as the information relates to grid mapping. Furthermore, DEF asserts that the Company treats the highlighted information provided in Document No. 02631-2025 as private and has not publicly disclosed it.

Staff has reviewed the document and concurs with DEF that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(c), Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would impair the security measures and business operations. Therefore, staff recommends the request by DEF for confidential classification of Document No. 02631-2025 be approved.
