CHAIRMAN LA ROSA: Let's move to 19.

Mr. Ward, we are ready when you are.

MR. WARD: Good afternoon Commissioners.

Oakley Ward with the Division of Economics.

Item 19 is a petition by Duke Energy Florida, LLC, for the closure and eventual termination of the My Energy Bill+ Program.

The My Energy Bill+ Program is a fixed bill program that allows Duke to have limited control of a participating customer's thermostat. In exchange for this control, participating customers pay a fixed monthly bill for a year with no true-up costs.

Duke stated that after sending over 350,000 customers multiple direct marketing offers, only 142 customers enrolled in the program. As a result, Duke is seeking to close and terminate the program due to a lack of customer interest.

Duke stated that if approved, the utility would work with customers to transition them to an alternative rate schedule. Customers will be transferred to the Fixed Bill Program, Budget Billing or return to their previous standard rate schedule.

1 Staff believes that the proposal is reasonable
2 and recommends approval. If approved, the program
3 will be closed to new customers as of August 1st,
4 2025.

5 Additionally, staff should be given
6 administrative authority to approve the tariffs to
7 eliminate the program once staff has confirmed that
8 all customers have been removed.

9 CHAIRMAN LA ROSA: Great. Thank you.
