Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Duke Energy Florida, LLC (DEF or Company) filed a request for confidential classification of Document No. 01395-2025 on March 27, 2025. This document contains highlighted information provided in its response to Staff's First Data Request (Nos. 1–23), specifically No. 20. The highlighted confidential information within Document No. 01395-2025 can be described as competitively sensitive commercial information regarding DEF's Asset Optimization Activities.

In its request for confidentiality, DEF asserts that disclosure of this information would harm the Company as the information relates to proprietary confidential business information. Furthermore, DEF states that the Company treats the highlighted information provided in Document No. 01395-2025 as private and has not publicly disclosed it. DEF alleges that if the information was disclosed, it may impair the Company's ability to contract for goods and services on favorable terms and also impair the competitive business interests of the provider of the information.

Staff has reviewed DEF's confidentiality request and agrees that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(d) and (e), F.S., whereby disclosure of the information would impair DEF's ability to contract for goods or services on favorable terms and impair the competitive business interests of DEF. Therefore, staff recommends that the request for confidentiality of information included in Document No. 01395-2025 be approved.
