Re: Docket No. 20250084-SU – Application for staff-assisted rate case in Orange County, by Gulfstream Utility LLC.

Dear Mr. Friedman:

Staff has completed its initial review of your application and has determined that Gulfstream Utility LLC (Utility or Gulfstream) is eligible for a staff-assisted rate case (SARC). The filing fee for this rate case is \$1,000 based on the capacity of the Utility's wastewater system as provided by Section 367.145(2), Florida Statutes (F.S) and Rule 25-30.020(2)(f), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). The filing fee must be received by **Friday, July 18, 2025**, which will be the official filing date for this rate case. **Pursuant to Rule 25-30.455(7), F.A.C., the Commission will deny the application if the utility does not remit the filing fee within 30 days after official acceptance.**

Please forward a copy of Gulfstream's application for a SARC to the Chief Executive Officer of Orange County. This is required by Section 367.091(2), F.S., which states:

Upon filing an application for new rates, the utility shall mail a copy of the application to the chief executive officer of the governing body of each county within the service areas included in the rate request. The governing body may petition the commission for leave to intervene in the rate change proceeding, and the commission shall grant intervenor status to any governing body that files a petition.
