The proposed increase would take a water bill with an average of around \$15 per month to more than \$100 a month. This is an excessive increase and would create a hardship for myself and many residents in Water Oak who are retired and live on a fixed income. Water is essential and we have no other viable alternative,

An increase of this magnitude is neither reasonable nor affordable.

Sun Communities raises our lot rent the maximum every year while their CEO makes 1.9 million a year. Those of us less fortunate, need to have a voice to stop this proposal! Please hear us!

I respectfully urge the commission to reject or significantly reduce this proposed rate increase and to prioritize affordability and consumer protection for residents of Water Oak.
