I am a retired customer of Water Oak Utility in Lake County and I am writing to oppose the proposed water rate increase under Docket No. 20250088-WU.

The proposed increase—from an average of about \$15 per month to more than \$100 per month—is excessive and would create a serious financial hardship for retirees living on fixed incomes. Water is an essential service, and customers have no alternative provider. An increase of this magnitude is neither reasonable nor affordable. I respectfully urge the Commission to reject or significantly reduce

this proposed rate increase and to prioritize affordability and consumer protection for residents of Water Oak.
