I feel the proposed increase in water rates for residents of Water Oak is an excessive increase. Many of our residents are on fixed incomes.

Also, I would be curious to know if the \$342,931 included water usage by the park itself, i.e. office, clubhouse, pools, etc. That expense should be absorbed by the park's operating expenses and absorbed through the rental income, not passed through to the residents.

The delivery of water via the park's system is not exemplary. There are frequent water line breaks in the system, which result in lack of water and the need to boil water once reconnected.
