We are retired homeowners in the Water Oak Community and are serviced by Water Oak Utility for our water needs. SUN Communities has requested an outrageous increase in the water rates for its customers. As there is no alternative available for water, we believe this increase will be detrimental to most of the residents in the Water Oak community. It is almost akin to elder abuse, with the way SUN increases the rent, taxes, amenities, and now water increases. Most Water Oak residents are retired and live on limited, fixed incomes. Sun Corporate has no concern with the residents of this community as long as they get their million-dollar bonuses. Little to no updates are made to this community, with the exception of the restaurant, which has been remodeled 3 times in the past few years. Water mains breaking and boil water notices are a normal thing here.
