This letter is intended as a formal protest of the proposed 400% increase to our water and wastewater rates at Water Oak Utility. Water Oak Country Club Estates is a 55+ Mobile home park in Lady Lake, Florida that is owned by Sun Communities.

According to the expenses and revenues report posted on the Sun Communities web site, their investors' revenue far exceeds their expenses. The company has not provided sufficient data that the infrastructure improvements or costs justify a 400% increase to my household

for water. We have owned our home in Water Oak since 2015. This is exceptionally difficult for those of us who are living on a fixed income.

Therefore, we protest this requested increase, because it is unjust and disproportionate to the cost of services provided. Such a large increase seems incredibly unfair to all the residents of Water Oak.

Please regard this letter as our formal, written objection to what we believe is an unjust and unnecessary increase in water rates at Water Oak.

We are also requesting that FPSC investigate the rate-setting methodology of the Sun Communities Finance LLC D/B/A Water Oak Utility.
