**FLORIDA RISING'S NOTICE OF JOINDER IN
CITIZENS' RESPONSE TO PETITION FOR LIMITED PROCEEDING
TO APPROVE LARGE LOAD TARIFF BY DUKE ENERGY FLORIDA, LLC**

Florida Rising, Inc. ("Florida Rising") hereby gives notice that it joins in full the Citizens' Response to Petition for Limited Proceeding to Approve Large Load Tariff by Duke Energy Florida, LLC, filed April 29, 2026, except for paragraph 16. Florida Rising understands the need for urgency for Duke Energy Florida ("Duke") to have a large load tariff approved so that large load customers, and all other customers, can have certainty regarding what the costs and policies to serve those customers will be and how other customers, including Florida Rising's members, will be protected from needing to shoulder the costs to serve those new, large load customers. However, Florida Rising also agrees that this case of first impression regarding how to implement SB 484, if signed into law, needs to be considered carefully, and a hearing date of less than three months from now would provide little time for discovery and the careful and thoughtful development of intervenor testimony. Florida Rising believes that the best interests of all would be served by convening the parties that have indicated they are intervening in this docket and Duke together and seeing if a mutually agreeable schedule can be agreed-to. The undersigned will remain available to work with all parties on a mutually agreeable schedule.
