By this letter, the Commission staff requests that Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) provide responses to the following data requests:

Please refer to Exhibits AM-1 through AM-3, and Appendices B through D of the petition filed October 29, 2024, for the following questions.

1. Refer to Exhibit AM-1 and Appendix B. For Hurricane Debby, please explain why there was a reduction in costs from the petition to the testimony in the amounts identified below for each of the following categories:
  - a. Contractors - \$18.06 million
  - b. Line Clearing - \$4.206 million
  - c. Vehicle & Fuel - \$0.299 million
  - d. Materials & Supplies - \$1.337 million
2. Refer to Exhibit AM-1 and Appendix B. For Hurricane Debby, please explain why there was an increase in costs from the petition to the testimony for the Logistics category by \$3.245 million.

3. Refer to Exhibit AM-2 and Appendix C. For Hurricane Helene, please explain why there was a reduction in costs from the petition to the testimony for the Line Clearing category by \$0.654 million.
4. Refer to Exhibit AM-2 and Appendix C. For Hurricane Helene, please explain why there was an increase in costs from the petition to the testimony in the amounts identified below for each of the following categories:
  - a. Contractors - \$6.984 million
  - b. Vehicle & Fuel - \$3.900 million
  - c. Materials & Supplies - \$2.426 million
  - d. Logistics - \$1.443 million
5. Refer to Exhibit AM-3 and Appendix D. For Hurricane Milton, please explain why there was a reduction in the total retail incremental storm costs from the petition to the testimony by \$36.710 million.
