Re: 20240172-EI, Petition for recovery of costs associated with named tropical systems during the 2023 and 2024 hurricane seasons and replenishment of storm reserve, by Tampa Electric Company.

Dear Mr. Teitzman:

On December 27, 2024, Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or the "company") filed a Petition for Recovery of Costs Associated with Named Tropical Systems during the 2023 and 2024 Hurricane Seasons and Replenishment of Storm Reserve. The Petition requested that the Commission approve a storm restoration surcharge to: (a) recover incremental storm restoration costs related to Hurricanes Idalia, Debby, Helene, and Milton and (b) replenish the company's storm reserve. The Commission approved an interim storm restoration surcharge to collect approximately \$466.7 million subject to refund and a final true-up, based on an 18-month recovery period beginning with the first billing cycle of March 2025 and continuing through August 2026 by Order No. PSC-2025-0062-PCO-EI, issued February 24, 2025 ("Recovery Order").

Tampa Electric's current calculations estimate that the storm restoration cost will be fully recovered one month early and the storm restoration surcharge can be removed from customer bills effective with the last billing cycle of July 2026. Terminating the surcharge will reduce a typical 1,000 kWh residential customer bill by approximately \$19.95 per month.

The company's proposed updated tariff sheets (clean and redline) showing termination of the storm restoration surcharge are attached as Exhibit A. The company requests that Commission staff administratively approve the updated tariff sheets so the company may cease collecting the surcharge effective with the last billing cycle of July 2026.
