Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida City Gas (FCG or Company) filed a request for confidential classification of certain information sent in response to Citizens' second request for Production of Documents (POD). More specifically, the confidential information relates to POD No. 26.

According to FCG, the information in POD No. 26 contains competitively sensitive salary information and sensitive customer account information. Specifically, the information contains executive compensation information, detailed compensation information for a range of employees, and customer specific account information. The disclosure of which would cause harm to FCG and its customers by impairing FCG's competitive business interests.

Staff has reviewed FCG's confidentiality request and agrees that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S. Therefore staff recommends that the request for confidentiality of certain information included in Document No. 03061-2026 be approved.
